

**BULLITT EAST HIGH SCHOOL
ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB
SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS**

The Bullitt East Athletic Booster Club (BEABC) will award a one-time scholarship to qualified, graduating seniors at Bullitt East High School. Students must meet **ALL** of the following requirements to be eligible to apply.

1. The student must be a US citizen and a senior at Bullitt East High School (BEHS).
2. The student must be a participating senior in a athletic program at Bullitt East High School and must have participated for 2 years while at Bullitt East, one of which must be their senior year. A participant is defined as a player, manager, trainer, statistician, cheerleader, and/or dance team member. A student's eligibility in the event of or unforeseen accidents will be determined by the selection committee.
3. The student must have a cumulative grade average of at least 3.0 at the end of the first semester of his/her senior year.
4. Parent(s) or legal guardian must be a member of the BEABC for 2 years. Attend at least three (3) meetings per school year of each membership year. It is required that they work at least three (3) bingos in each of the two afore mentioned membership years, with one year being the students senior year. Bingo must be worked for the sport/student that is applying for the scholarship.

Note: The school year is defined as July 1 - June 30.

Senior year is defined as July 1-March 31 to allow time for scholarship consideration.

5. The student **MUST COMPLETE** an application form. Applications for the Scholarship must be postmarked on or before March 31, 2019. Application forms are to be mailed to:

6. As part of the application, the student is required to write an essay of at least 300 words explaining how Bullitt East High School Athletics prepared them to meet their career goals. The essay should be a word document and mailed to BEAB by midnight on March 31, 2019.
7. An official transcript must also be included with the application, and **must be** signed by the school counselor.
8. A selection committee will meet and review the applications prior to the May Booster Club meeting to select the students who will be awarded the scholarships. The selection committee will be composed of (1) Booster Club member, (1) Member of the Booster Club Board, (1) BEHS Faculty member, excluding senior parents and legal guardians. The committee is to be determined by general membership at a regular meeting.
9. The selection committee will present the names of the students to receive a scholarship at the May meeting. Students selected will be notified by mail.
10. Scholarship awards will be made out to the students chosen college. The scholarship amount will be contingent upon the success of our fundraising activities. All eligible recipients will receive the same amount of money.
11. Maximum individual scholarship awarded will be \$2,500
12. Special circumstances concerning requirements may be considered by the Scholarship Selection Committee.
