

**Bullitt County Public Schools: Non-Traditional Instruction (NTI) School Day**  
*Information Sheet*

***What is a Non-Traditional Instruction (NTI) School Plan?***

This is a plan that provides detail on how ALL students will continue to receive instruction on a day when school is not open due to unpredictable circumstances. The plan provides teachers a time to provide learning activities and opportunities in a variety of ways (online and paper-based) that still allow students to learn and master grade-level standards along with individual support as necessary. This plan provides a unique and alternative use of instruction time while preparing students to learn new content when school is back in session.

***How will instruction and content be delivered?***

Instruction will be delivered through online and/or paper-based assignments. Your child's school will provide you with information on how instruction will be delivered through digital platforms. In addition, paper copies will be provided for your student if there is no device and/or wifi at home. If your child needs paper copies of assignments, your child's school will communicate where and how to receive paper-based assignments.

***When will instruction be delivered?***

Instruction will be delivered from ***Monday, March 16th*** to ***Friday, March 27th***. During this time frame, teachers will be required to maintain an online presence for assistance from 8:15-11:15 AM and 12:15-3:15 PM. Students and parents will be able to communicate with their teacher or principal via email, phone, or other electronic communication methods.

***When will this be communicated?***

Bullitt County Public Schools will communicate to all students, parents, and staff when Non-Traditional Instruction days will begin via Infinite Campus Messenger and social media outlets.

***How will my child's attendance and participation be accounted for?***

Student participation and completion of online or paper-based assignments are connected to your child's attendance on non-traditional instruction days. Supports will be provided on an individual basis for any extenuating circumstances for work completion. Teachers will also be keeping a record of communication via Infinite Campus on non-traditional instruction days to help monitor student participation.

***Will students have access to School Meals?***

Yes. School Nutrition Services is working with the district Transportation Department to ensure meals will be available throughout the county for students. Information on specific locations and sites to pick up meals will be communicated via the district website and social media. Meal service times will occur between 10:30 am and 12:30 pm.
