Dear Parent/Guardian:

Now that your child has turned 16, we need to let you know of an immunization requirement that was changed in July 1, 2018 for this age population:

Students aged 16 years or older, must show proof of having received two doses of Meningococcal ACWY vaccine (MenACWY) to attend school. If the first dose of MenACWY was received at sixteen (16) years or older, the second dose is not required for school entry.

To meet this requirement, a current Certificate of Immunization Status must be provided to the school in the next two weeks showing the date your child received this vaccine.

School districts are mandated to enforce this law on behalf of the State Department of Health. Per Bullitt County requirements for enrollment as stated in 09.121 AP.1, each child shall have been immunized according to testing and immunization schedules established by regulations of the Cabinet for Health Services. Medical or Religious Exemptions can apply to testing or immunization requirements.

Children who are not adequately immunized, in progress, or properly exempted, may be excluded from school until a new form is brought to the school.
