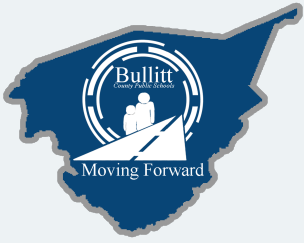


# COVID-19 STUDENT PROTOCOLS

## Bullitt County Public Schools



### COVID-19 SYMPTOMS



- Temperature > 100.4
- Chills
- **NEW** Uncontrolled Cough that Causes Difficulty Breathing
- Shortness of Breath
- Loss of taste or smell
- Vomiting/Diarrhea
- New rash

### Student Presents COVID-19 Symptoms but Has Not Been Tested

1. Contact your school's Attendance Clerk AND your Extra-Curricular Coach/Sponsor, and complete the [COVID-19 Student Report](#); Coach/Sponsor notifies Athletics Director
2. Attendance Clerk/AD notifies the building Principal, Lesa Howell, & Jesse Bacon
  - **Option 1 (Recommended):** Contact your medical provider to get tested
    - Student may return to school/activities with a negative COVID-19 test OR a definitive alternate diagnosis from a physician (e.g. ear infection, strep throat, etc.)
  - **Option 2:** Stay home, and monitor further symptoms for 72 hours
    - Student may return to work/activities when symptom-free for 72 hours AND is fever-free for 72 hours without fever-reducing medication
    - If symptoms continue beyond 72 hours contact the COVID-19 district nurse hotline at 502-869-4636
3. The Attendance Clerk checks in with student daily
4. The student may participate in Remote Learning until they are released to come back to school and/or participate in extracurricular activities



### Student With a Positive COVID-19 Test With Symptoms

1. Contact your school's Attendance Clerk AND your Extra-Curricular Coach/Sponsor, and complete the [COVID-19 Student Report](#); Coach/Sponsor notifies Athletics Director
2. Attendance Clerk/AD notifies the building Principal, Lesa Howell, & Jesse Bacon
3. Principal sends letter to staff and students based on consultation with Lesa Howell
4. Immediate isolation/quarantine shall occur and continue for:
  - At least 10 days since the symptoms started; AND
  - Until symptoms experienced are improving; AND
  - Fever-free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication
5. The Attendance Clerk checks in with student daily
6. Student provides their Attendance Clerk a return-to-school letter from BCHD, healthcare provider, or testing facility.
7. The student may participate in Remote Learning until they are released to come back to school and/or participate in extracurricular activities



# COVID-19 STUDENT PROTOCOLS

### Student Tests Positive with NO Symptoms



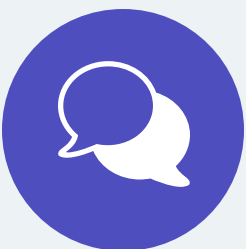
1. Contact your school's Attendance Clerk AND your Extra-Curricular Coach/Sponsor, and complete the [COVID-19 Student Report](#); Coach/Sponsor notifies Athletics Director
2. Attendance Clerk/AD notifies the building Principal, Lesa Howell, & Jesse Bacon
3. Principal sends letter to staff and students based on consultation with Lesa Howell
4. Immediate isolation/quarantine shall occur and continue for at least 10 days after test date. Self-monitor for signs and symptoms, if symptoms develop within 10 days, individual will need to follow Student Test Positive for COVID-19 w/Symptoms
5. The Attendance Clerk checks in with student daily
6. Student provides their Attendance Clerk a return-to-school letter from BCHD, healthcare provider, or testing facility.
7. The student may participate in Remote Learning until they are released to come back to school and/or participate in extracurricular activities

### Student With a Positive COVID-19 Case in the Household



1. Contact your school's Attendance Clerk AND your Extra-Curricular Coach/Sponsor, and complete the [COVID-19 Student Report](#); Coach/Sponsor notifies Athletics Director
2. Attendance Clerk/AD notifies the building Principal, Lesa Howell, & Jesse Bacon
3. Immediate isolation/quarantine shall occur and continue for 14 days after the positive household member has recovered. Recovery requires:
  - 10 days after the positive household member has been diagnosed: AND
  - positive household member symptoms are improving; AND
  - Household member is fever-free for 72 hours without the use of fever-reducing medication
4. The Attendance Clerk checks in with student daily
5. If the student does not have a return-to-school letter, communication with a BCPS nurse through the COVID-19 District Nurse hotline at 502-869-4636 is required before returning
6. The student may participate in Remote Learning until they are released to come back to school and/or participate in extracurricular activities

### Student Receives a Quarantine Order from the Health Department or Contact Tracers



1. Contact your school's Attendance Clerk AND your Extra-Curricular Coach/Sponsor, and complete the [COVID-19 Student Report](#); Coach/Sponsor notifies Athletics Director
2. Attendance Clerk/AD notifies the building Principal, Lesa Howell, & Jesse Bacon
3. If symptom develops, follow **Student Test Positive for COVID-19 w/Symptoms**.
4. The student may participate in Remote Learning until they are released to come back to school and/or participate in extracurricular activities
